Safeguarding

Grounds Training do not arrange training for people under 16 years of age.

Vulnerable adult at risk

A brief definition of such a person is that he or she:

- » has needs for care and support
- » is experiencing, or at risk of abuse or neglect
- » is unable to protect themselves against significant harm or exploitation

In order to minimize putting vulnerable adults at risk, the client is asked to complete a declaration that the proposed course participant is fit and able to undertake the training, and to state whether the course participant is considered to be vulnerable adult.

If the latter is confirmed, the Instructor and Assessor will be informed and made aware of the need to treat the course participant appropriately in terms of personal behavior, appropriate language and appropriate interaction during training and assessment.

Any complaints which arise because of the course participant's status as a vulnerable person will be investigated in the manner prescribed in the Company's Complaints policy, and will involve other agencies such as Social Services and parents, as necessary.
